WHEREAS, AGL Resources, NJR Pipeline Company, South Jersey Industries, UGI Energy Services and Public Service Electric and Gas are proposing to construct new 30-inch or 36-inch-diameter natural gas pipeline infrastructure through West Amwell Township in New Jersey, as part of the PennEast Pipeline proposal;

WHEREAS, the proposed PennEast pipeline poses a potential and significant threat to the safety of students, staff, and property of the South Hunterdon Regional High School community, being that the preliminary track of the pipeline passes within 630 feet of the high school; and

WHEREAS, such placement would put the School within the Potential Impact Radius (PIR) in the event of an explosion or other disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Board has a solemn responsibility to provide a safe environment for our students, faculty, and administration, and this proposed pipeline route would jeopardize the ability of the Board to meet that mission;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the South Hunterdon Regional School District that the Board opposes the proposed route of the PennEast pipeline, or any alternate route that would place any of the facilities of the South Hunterdon Regional School District, or its busing routes, within the pipeline's Potential Impact Radius; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an authenticated copy of this resolution be forwarded to the City of Lambertville, Borough of Stockton, and Township of West Amwell, the Hunterdon County Board of Chosen Freeholders, United States Senators Robert Me-nendez and Cory Booker, United States Representative Leonard Lance, State Senators Christopher "Kip" Bateman and Shirley K. Turner, and Assemblyman Jack Ciattarelli, Assemblyman Reed Gusciora, Assemblywoman Donna Simon, and Assemblywoman Bonnie Watson Coleman.
